# **About the KHS Scholarship Center**

The KHS Scholarship Center exists to help students seek out and apply for scholarships. While this is ultimately the student's responsibility, Counseling Office personnel have established a system of helping alert students to current scholarships available.

The success of the Scholarship Center is based largely on the quality and accuracy of the information students give on their **Student Profile Form**. Students will fill out this form in September of their senior year. This form will be found online as a link on the KHS Scholarship page. It is very helpful if students update this form as they narrow down their career and college choices. It is also very helpful if parents make their children aware of any key information such as their military service or membership in local and national organizations. These profiles are helpful in matching students with scholarships that have specific eligibility requirements. Many scholarships, however, have minimal eligibility requirements so students will not always be notified of a scholarship match due to the high number of students who qualify.

Scholarships are posted on KHS daily announcements, the bulletin board in the hallway, and the Scholarship Website. A link to this website is found at the top of the Kingsford High School webpage or by going to <a href="http://www.kingsford.org/khsWeb/counseling\_office/default.php">http://www.kingsford.org/khsWeb/counseling\_office/default.php</a>. Scholarship opportunities will begin being posted on this website beginning in September and then weekly throughout the school year as the due dates near. If the instructions are to bring your application to the Scholarship Center, please follow the due dates on the scholarship website, not the application form. This will ensure ample time for the Scholarship Center to process and mail your application. It is important that students check this website weekly for new scholarship opportunities. The majority of the applications can be accessed on this website and will be able to be completed online. Please type whenever possible. I will be happy to review your application; however, you will need to get the application to me at least a week before the due date.

Students will need a least two **letters of recommendation** to begin applying for most scholarships. One should be from a teacher, and one should be from someone outside of school that is not a relative. Please ask for these letters well in advance. September would be a good goal. Please provide the person you are requesting a letter from a list of your activities and honors so he/she can incorporate this information into the letter. You may use your activity sheet for this purpose. <a href="http://khsscholarships.weebly.com/scholarship-application-activities-sheet.html">http://khsscholarships.weebly.com/scholarship-application-activities-sheet.html</a>. A link to the activity sheet can also be found on the Counseling Office webpage and will also be emailed to you at the beginning of the school year. If letters of recommendation are written in such a way that they can be used for any application, they can be kept on file in the Counseling Office and included with any future applications.

ACT and SAT scores are often a determining factor for scholarship committees. You may want to consider retaking the ACT or SAT test if you think you can improve your score. The Counseling Office has prep materials for you to check out and use in preparing for a retake.

Many scholarship applications require an updated **transcript**. Students can request transcripts through **Parchment**. A link to this is found at the top of the KHS webpage. Students are responsible for printing their own transcripts unless the application requests an "official" transcript. You can then request that the Counseling Office print an official transcript for you.

Most scholarships require a written **essay**. While the topics may vary, once you have done two or three scholarship essays, you will begin to find it easy to use information from these essays to create a new one. These essays are very important and can be a determining factor in winning a scholarship. It is vital that you do you very best on these essays. Please have someone proofread your essay and give you feedback.

This guide includes descriptions of KHS and local scholarships and some additional scholarships of interest. This is not a comprehensive list of all the scholarships that will be posted. There are many more. Check the scholarship website weekly for these and other scholarship opportunities. Additional scholarships will become available throughout the school year and are not listed in this booklet. Students should be checking the scholarship website weekly.

The information provided in this guide may change from year to year. Eligibility requirements, due dates, and scholarship totals can vary from year to year.

- Applicants must document involvement in extra-curricular activities as well as provide documentation of at least 50 hours of community service.

## Kingsford High School Local Scholarship (varies)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.75 or higher
- Applicants must document involvement in extra-curricular activities as well as provide documentation of at least 50 hours of community service.
- Consideration will be given to applicants that have volunteered in any patriotic organization.

## Kingsford Middle School Scholarship (varies)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.5 or higher
- Applicant must have attended KMS for three years.
- Applicant must have 40 or more hours of documented community service.

## Kleiman (William and Elaine) Scholarship (varies)

Eligibility Requirements:

• GPA 2.5 or higher

## Lee (James F.) Memorial Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.5 or higher
- Applicant must pursue a degree in the field of education.

## Mette (W. Glenn and Ella) Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Requirements:

• GPA 2.7 or higher

Eligibility Requirements:

• GPA 2.0 or higher

Eligibility Requirements:

• GPA 2.0 or higher

### Nelson (John D.) Memorial Scholarship \$500)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.75 or higher
- Must attend a vocational/technical school.
- Preference to student majoring in welding.

## Olsen (Irving G. Nursing) Scholarship (varies)

- GPA 2.75 or higher
- · Applicant must major in the nursing field.
- Applicant must attend Bay College.

## Schniderele, Ray Memorial Scholarship (\$1000)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 3.0 or higher
- Applicant must be pursuing a degree or a career in the arts or involved in the music/band program.

## Spencer (Robert) Memorial Scholarship (varies)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 3.0 or higher
- Preference to Education or Automotive majors.

## Specialty Granules Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Requirements:

• Applicant must be accepted for admission to any accredited post-secondary school

## Spigarelli (Tony) Memorial Soccer Scholarship (\$1000)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.0 or higher
- Applicant must have played at least one full season on the KHS boys or girls soccer team.
- Applicant must attach a copy of the "letter of acceptance" from the college/university you
  plan to attend.

## St. Louis (Robert) Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Requirements:

• GPA 3.0 or higher

## Student Council Scholarship (varies)

Eligibility Requirements:

Applicant must be an active member of Student Council (one year minimum required).

## U.P. Whitetails Scholarship (\$1500)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.0 or higher
- Applicant must study in a conservation related field.

## June D. Waisanen Memorial Scholarship (\$5,000 and \$2,500)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and be attending a 4 year college or university for the \$5000 scholarship.
- Applicant must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher and be attending a 2 year vocational or technical school for the \$2500 scholarship.

## Woodland PTO Scholarship (varies)

- GPA 3.0
- Applicant must have attended Woodland Elementary for at least 3 years.

# Ziemba (Dr. Dennis and Carol) Fine Arts Memorial Scholarship (\$500)

- GPA 3.0
- Applicant must pursue a degree in the fine arts.
- An additional essay of 250-500 words. Topic: "What do you believe is the role of arts in society?"

## OTHER KHS SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are also for KHS seniors only; however, they require a separate application. They are usually posted in January or February and are due in March. Essays may be required. References may be required. Award amounts may vary from year to year. It is important to check the scholarship website for exact due dates, and additional scholarships may be added.

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 3.0 or higher
- Applicant must be attending a 4 year university or college.
- Applicant must major in the field of science.

## Bosley, Taylor Memorial Scholarship (varies)

Eligibility Requirements:

• GPA 2.5 or higher

## Collins, Eric G. Memorial (\$500)

Eligibility Requirements

- GPA 3.0 or higher
- Preference may be given to a KHS swim team or soccer team member.

## Good Earth Salon Scholarship (\$1000)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.5 or higher
- Applicant must be accepted for admission into an accredited cosmetology school.

## Holmes, Don Memorial-Kingsford Music Booster Club (\$500)

- GPA 2.5 or higher
- Applicant must be enrolled in a music program at KHS.
- Applicant must be pursuing a degree in and post-secondary institution of higher learning.
- Applicant must continue participation in a post-secondary institution of higher learning sponsored performing ensemble.

## Hometowne Lumber Scholar-Athlete Scholarship (\$300)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 3.0 or higher
- Applicant must have earned 3 varsity letters.

## Key Club Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.5 or higher
- Must be a member (in good standing) of Key Club for at least two years.

## Kingsford High School Athletic Booster Club Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.5 or higher
- One male and one female award will be given.
- Applicant must have been involved in a sport all four years of high school.

## Kingsford High School Female Athlete Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.75 or higher
- Female
- Must have played on a least one varsity or junior varsity sport.

## Kingsford High School Football Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.5 or higher
- Applicant must have played varsity football.

## Kingsford High School Football Alumni Rae Drake Scholarship (\$500 renewable)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.0 or higher
- Applicant must have played varsity football.

## Kingsford Youth Wrestling Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be attending any post-secondary school of at least 9 months.
- Applicant must have participated in wrestling in high school.

## Lee (Beryl) Memorial Scholarship (2-\$500)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.75 or higher
- Involvement in the KHS Peer-to-Peer Program
- Any two or 4 year college or university

## Lions Club (Iron Mountain-Kingsford) Scholarship (\$500)

- Applicant must be accepted to an accredited post-secondary school.
- Community service will be taken into consideration.

## Marshall (Megan) Memorial Scholarship (varies)

Eligibility Requirements:

 Applicant must be pursuing a degree in education, physical therapy, occupational therapy, school psychology, counseling or related fields.

## McNeil (John and Stella) Scholarship (varies, renewable)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.0 or higher
- Applicants must be attending a 4 year university or college or a 2 year vocational or technical school.
- Several four-year scholarships and two-year scholarships are awarded.

## Merriman Farm Union Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be attending any post-secondary school of at least 9 months.
- Applicant must major in the natural resources area.

## Michigan Technological University Klungness, James A. (varies, renewable)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 3.5 or higher
- Applicant must be accepted for enrollment at Michigan Technological University in a baccalaureate degree program.

## Michigan Technological University Perla, Peter (varies, renewable)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.5 or higher
- Applicant must be accepted for enrollment at Michigan Technological University in a baccalaureate degree program.

### MJ Electric Scholarship (\$1000, renewable)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 2.5 or higher
- Applicant must be attending any 2 or 4 year college or university.
- Applicant must be majoring in the construction related field, business information technology, engineering, or similar fields of study.
- Initial consideration will be given to students who are related to current or previous employees of MJ Electric. Others should apply.

## Novickis, Kathleen Temple Scholarship (\$1000)

- GPA 3.25 or higher
- Documented leadership skills
- Preference given to those pursuing a degree in Business or Music or those that will
  participate in a musical performance group in college.

## Pancheri (Emanuel and Betty) Scholarship (\$1000)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 3.0 or higher
- Preference will be given to applicants that plan on attending a two-year community college.
- Preference will be given to applicants that reside in Quinnesec.

## Peterson Family Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Requirements:

 Applicant must have played on a KHS athletic team at least three years in the same sport, and one of them must be in his/her senior year.

## Raatz (Dr. Susan) Scholarship (\$1000)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA 3.0 or higher
- Applicant must be accepted for admission to an accredited four-year college or university.
- Applicant must be pursuing a degree in a science-related field.
- Preference will be given to applicants that have been involved in a dance program, as well as
  applicants that reside (or have recently resided) in the East Kingsford area.

### Red Cross Young Minds Scholarship (varies)

Eligibility Requirements:

• Applicant must be a National Honor Society member who has worked at a blood drive, or a student who has donated blood.

## Rice (Ryan) Memorial Scholarship (2-\$500 renewable)

Eligibility Requirements:

- GPA: 2.5 or higher
- Applicant must have been involved in a varsity sport.
- Applicant must exhibit good character.

## Skog, Dennis J. Memorial Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Financial need is the major consideration.
- Applicant must be accepted for admission to an accredited two or four-year college or university.
- Preference given to students attending Michigan State University.

## Treml, Jolene Memorial Scholarship (\$500)

Eligibility Requirements:
