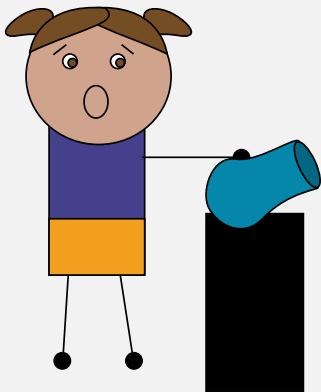


What is Honesty?

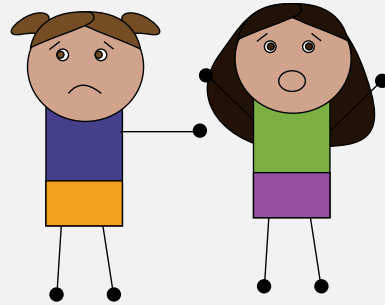
Honesty is being truthful in what you say and in what you do. You say what really happened, and you only do things you know are morally right.

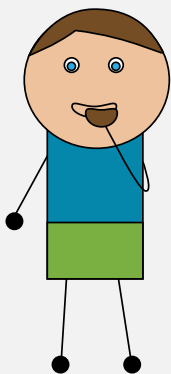





Being honest means you tell the whole truth. If you hide the truth, you are not being honest.


