Appointments

To schedule, change, cancel or confirm a clinic appointment, please contact the Appointment Center at 410-605-7333, Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. To schedule an acute appointment, please call the Telephone Care Line Monday through Friday (except holidays) from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at 800-865-2441. New Patients

Parking


Volunteer Coffee Stand







From Points North and South: Take I-95 to exit 93 for Route 222 east toward Perryville. At the end of the ramp, turn left onto Route 222 and proceed for about two miles to the end of the road. Turn left onto Broad Street. Continue for half a mile and turn right onto Ikea Way. In a quarter mile, turn right onto Marion Tapp Parkway. Follow the road until you come to the gated entrance of the medical center.

From the Eastern Shore: Take Route 50 west toward Baltimore. Turn right onto MD-213 and continue for approximately four miles. Merge onto US-301 north toward Wilmington, Delaware, and continue for approximately 23 miles. Turn left onto MD-313 north

and continue for approximately 2.5 miles through the Town of Galena. After passing through Galena, MD-313 will change to MD-213. Continue on MD-213 for approximately 20 miles and turn left onto US-40 west. Continue on US-40 for approximately 13 miles and turn left onto Coudon Boulevard. Continue for nearly a mile and turn left onto Ikea Way. In a quarter mile, turn right onto Marion Tapp Parkway. Follow the road until you come to the gated entrance of the medical center.
