Have you noticed anything new on our websites/search engines? Even though we do not collect any personal data from our users, we have converted all our sites to SSL. The usage of *SSL* ensures that all data transmitted between the web server and browser remains encrypted.

You can tell that a page is SSL secured if it has a green padlock and the URL begins with <https://> instead of <http://>
