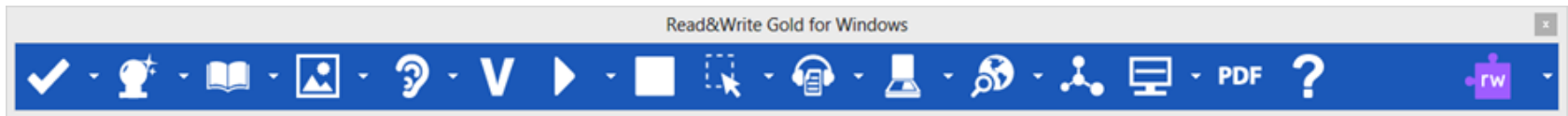

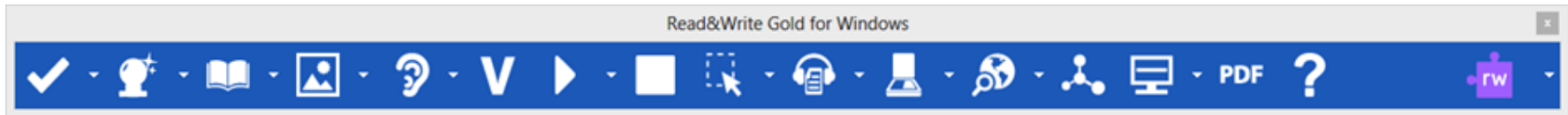
Training Objective: To become familiar with the key features, their functionality, and potential applications and benefits of the Read&Write 11.5 program for students and instructors.

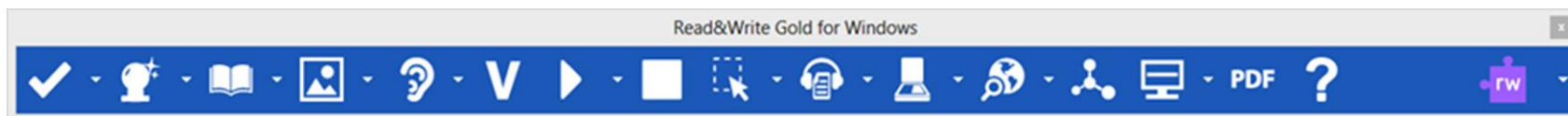

Read Aloud

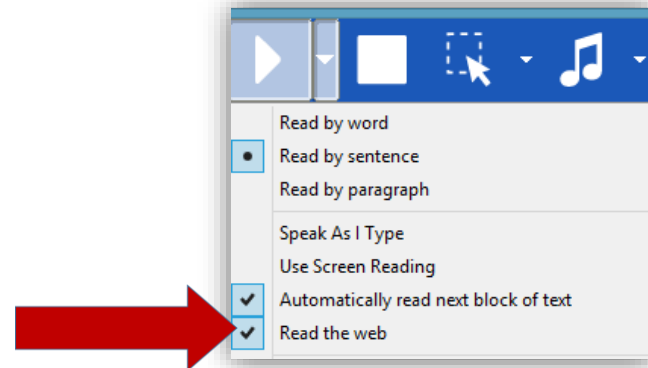
- Text-to-Speech
- Works on all documents in the Microsoft Office Suite (except PowerPoint) and web pages (HTML)
- Speech Options:
 - Adjust voices
 - English - Male or Female
 - Spanish - Paulina
 - Adjust pronunciations
 - Highlighting color choices
- Choice of on screen visual displays
- Aids with comprehension and proofing Word processing

The Gladiators of Ancient Rome

Gladiator fights were first introduced in 264 BC at the funeral of a nobleman, Junius Brutus. His sons revived an Etruscan custom of having slaves fight at a funeral of a great leader. It was believed a sacrifice would please the gods. In this first Gladiator fight, three pairs of slaves fought to the death. From then the ceremony was increasingly used to honour important men and emperors used them to show how powerful they were.

Read the Web

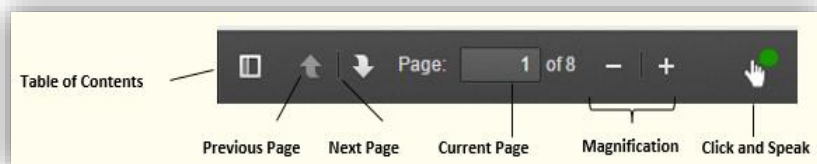
- Text-to-Speech
- Reads aloud on web pages (HTML)
- **NO CLICKING** or **HIGHLIGHTING** required
- Avoids accidental hyperlink launch
- Maintains dual color highlighting
- Works in accessible web pages
- Speech Options remain intact

PDF

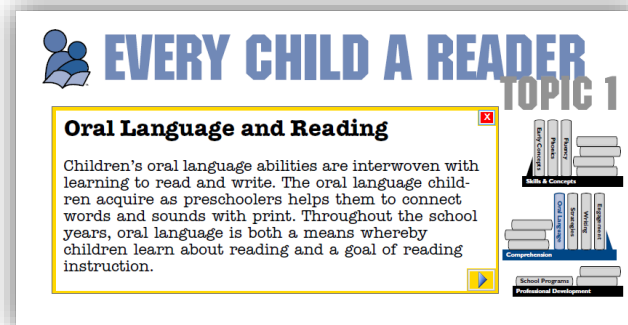
PDFAloud

- Text-to-Speech for accessible (unlocked) PDF's
- Accessible = OCR (Optical Character Recognition)
- Open PDF document using icon
- Click To Speak - default setting. Reads one sentence at a time.
- Allows for interaction with other Read&Write tools (Dictionary, Picture Dictionary, Highlighters, Collection of Highlights, Vocabulary List Builder and Paragraph Translator)

Screenshot Reader

- Text-to-Speech -- Selected text will be read aloud with highlighting
- Provides read aloud for "locked" files
- Reads virtually any text including images, Flash, and locked PDF documents
- Converts "screenshot" text to Word document for instructional adaptations

Scanning

Use our Scanning tool to run your documents through OCR (Optical Character Recognition).

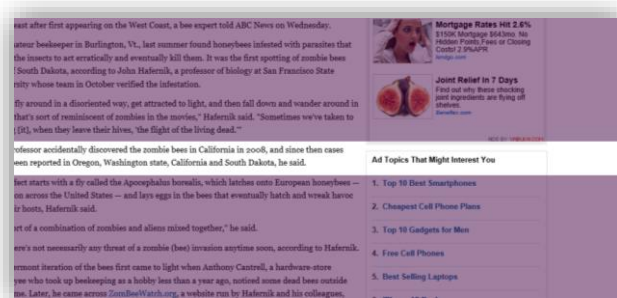
Scan to:

- **PDF** - the scanned image looks exactly the same as the source image. Recommended if layout retention is important.
- **Word** – used if editing the text is required.
- **HTML** - automatically converted into a font size, color and background color of choice.
- **ePub** – a standard format for eBooks
- Multi-page scanning available

Screen Masking

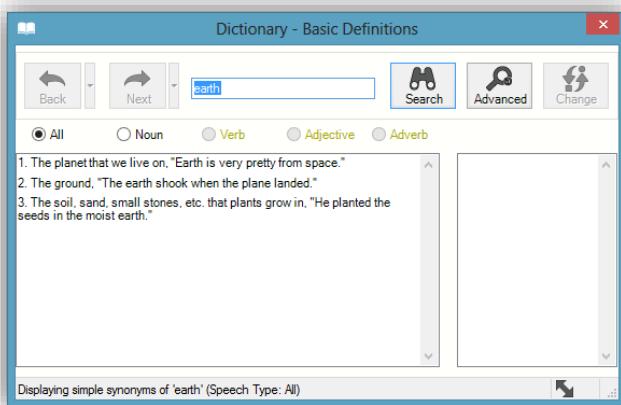
- Aids Reading Focus with color overlay or color line
- Aids Writing Focus for quick location of cursor
- Tint screen, window, and/or line
- Spotlight and underline width adjusts
- Choice of 48 basic colors + more custom colors

Dictionary

- **Choice of Basic, Advanced or Web**
- **Web definitions = Google dictionary**
- **Each definition gives part of speech and can be speech-enabled**
- **Sample sentences and descriptions included**

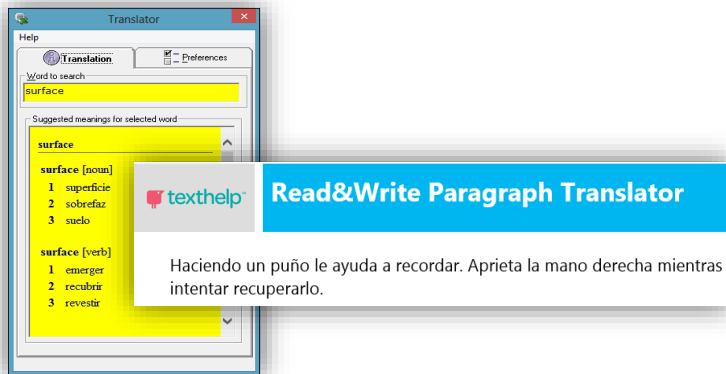
Picture Dictionary

- **Online dictionary tool finds images or symbols for selected word(s)**
- **More than 50,000 images/symbols**
- **Works with selected or clipboard text**
- **Requires online connection and gets faster as it caches the images**

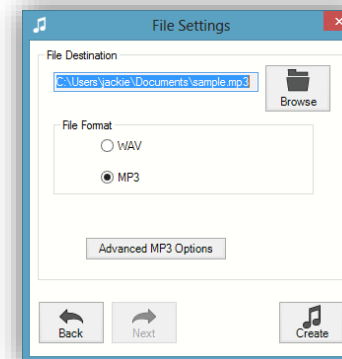
Translator

- Translate Single Word or Paragraph
- Many languages have translations which can be speech-enabled
- Requires internet for paragraph translation
- Paragraph translator contains 52 Language translation choices

Speech Maker

- Converts digital text into a sound file such as MP3 or WAV.
- Works on any unlocked digital text
- Up to 20,000 characters at one time can be selected to Allow for voice choice, selection of speed and pitch
- Helpful for auditory learners, repeated reading, and memorization.

Highlighters






- Highlighted info is collected by:
 - color
 - collection time or
 - position in document
- Highlighted info can be exported to a new Word document with bibliographical info
- Bibliographic info for APA, MLA or Harvard formats is gathered

Vocabulary List Builder

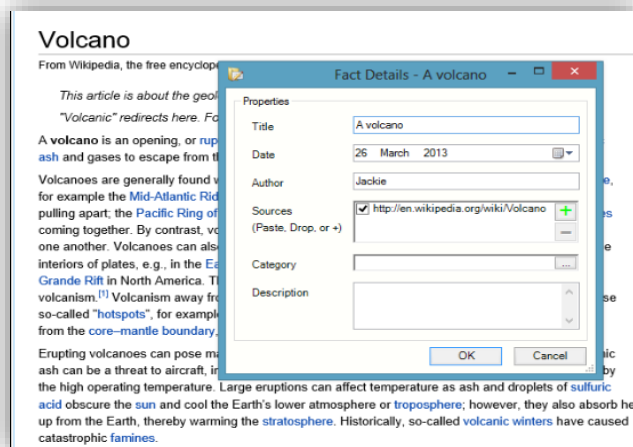
- Highlight or enter words manually for creation of graphic organizer
- Creates a Word document with columns:
 - vocabulary word
 - word meaning
 - symbol for word (if available)
 - note column

- Research aid with Source cited
- Information can be converted to MS Word
- Bibliographical information collected for APA, MLA and Harvard formats

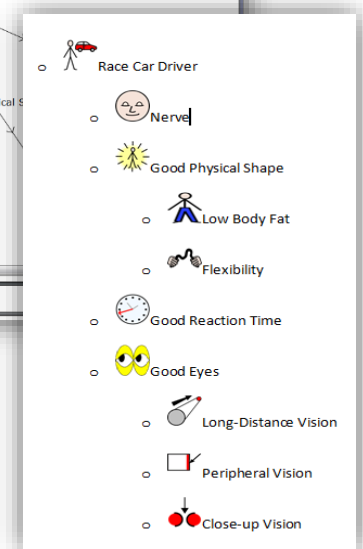
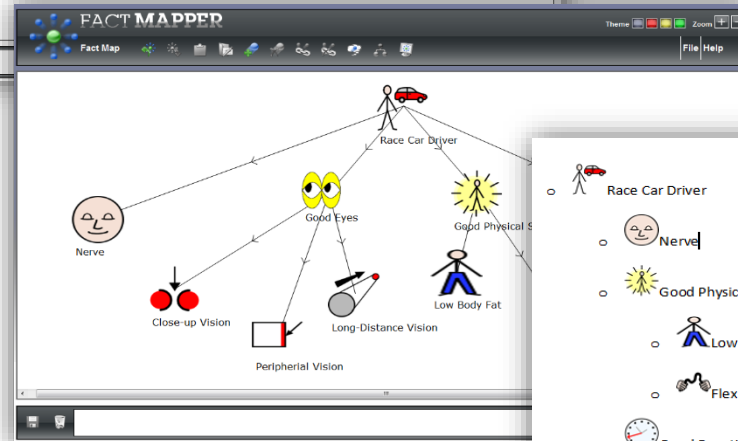
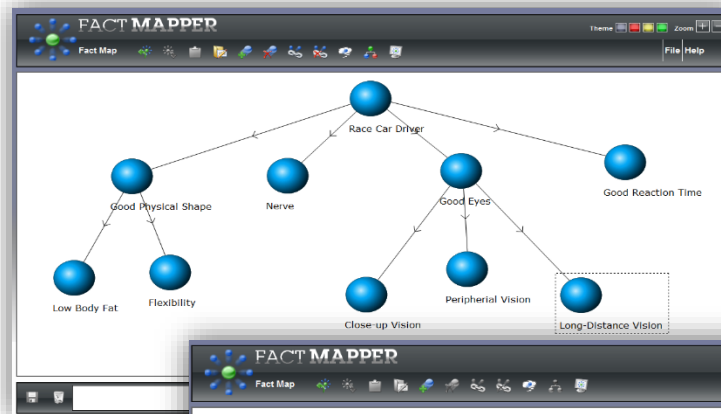
Fact Finder

- Performs Internet search on word or topic
- Range of search engine choices
- Launches from any application
- Efficient way of searching on a given subject
- Gives opportunity for quick look up for background information while reading

Fact Mapper

- Online Mind Mapping/Graphic Organizing tool
- Brainstorm, Revise, Outline for Writing
- Add elements to your screen
- Add images to the map elements
- Adjust the layout of map elements
- Export the Fact Map to MS Word and save the file or Save the Fact Map

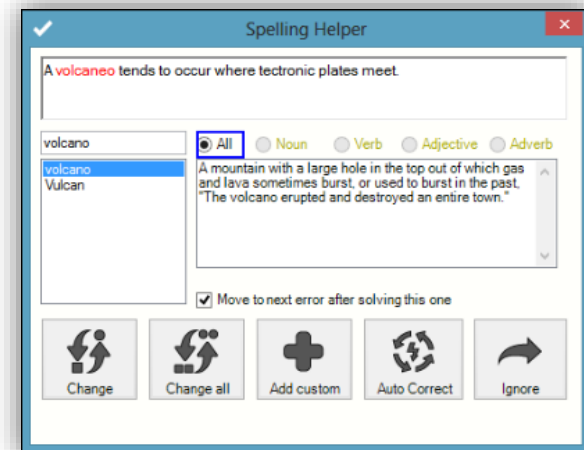
Word Prediction

Spelling Checker

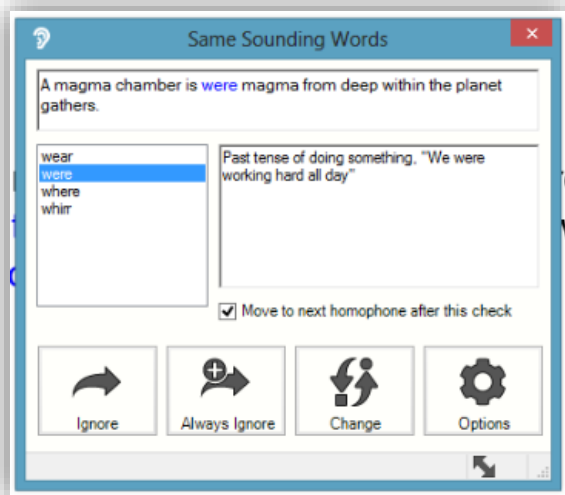
- Suggestions made based on phonetic-based mapping

Sounds Like and Confusable Words

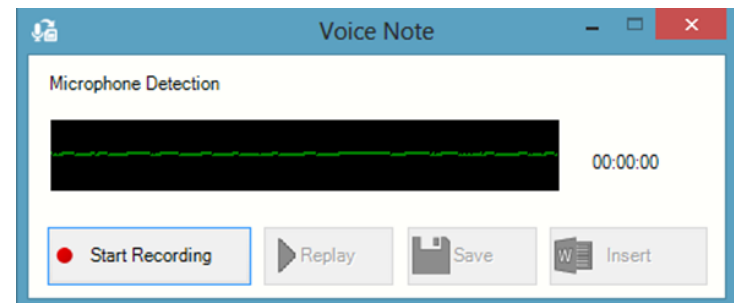


- Highlights homophones and words that are easily confused

Voice Note

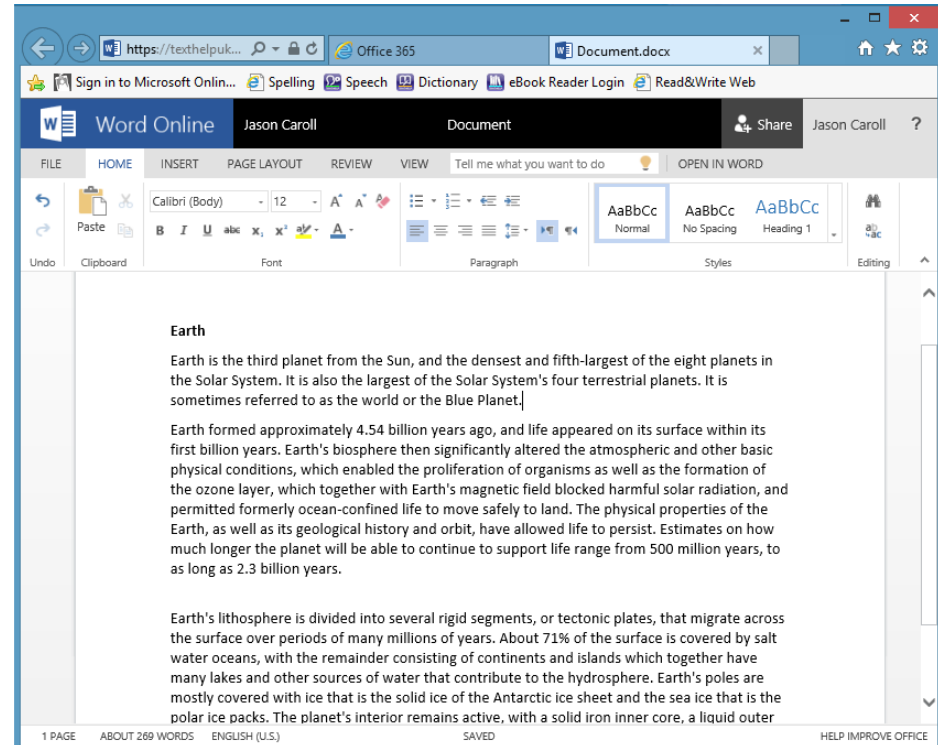
- Make an MP3 voice recording
- Insert the recording into your Word document indicated by this icon 
- Allows for multiple voice comments on one document
- Share document and add voice recordings from additional people

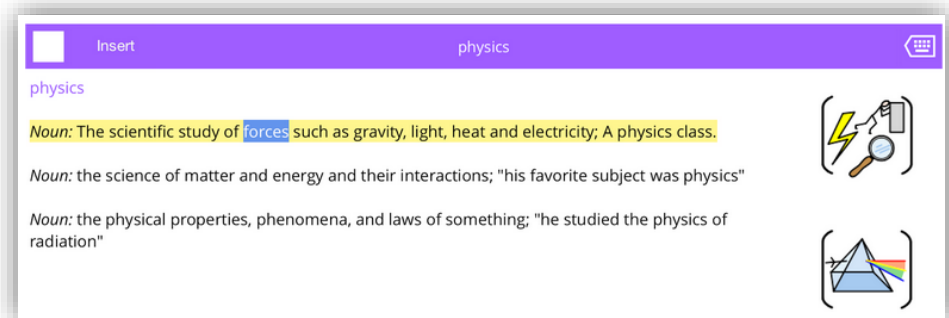
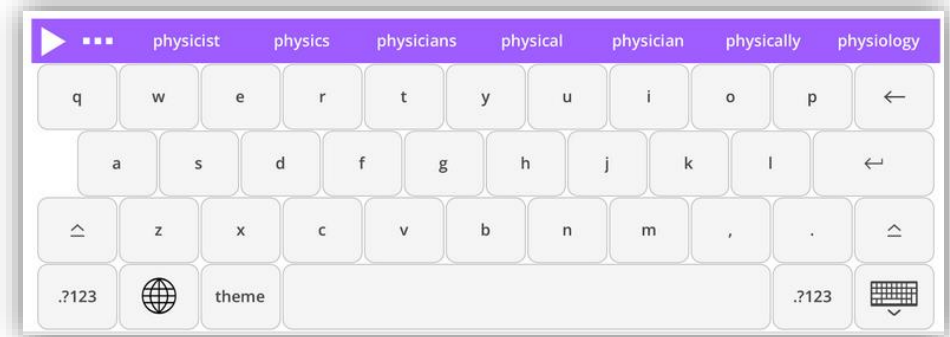
