# ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

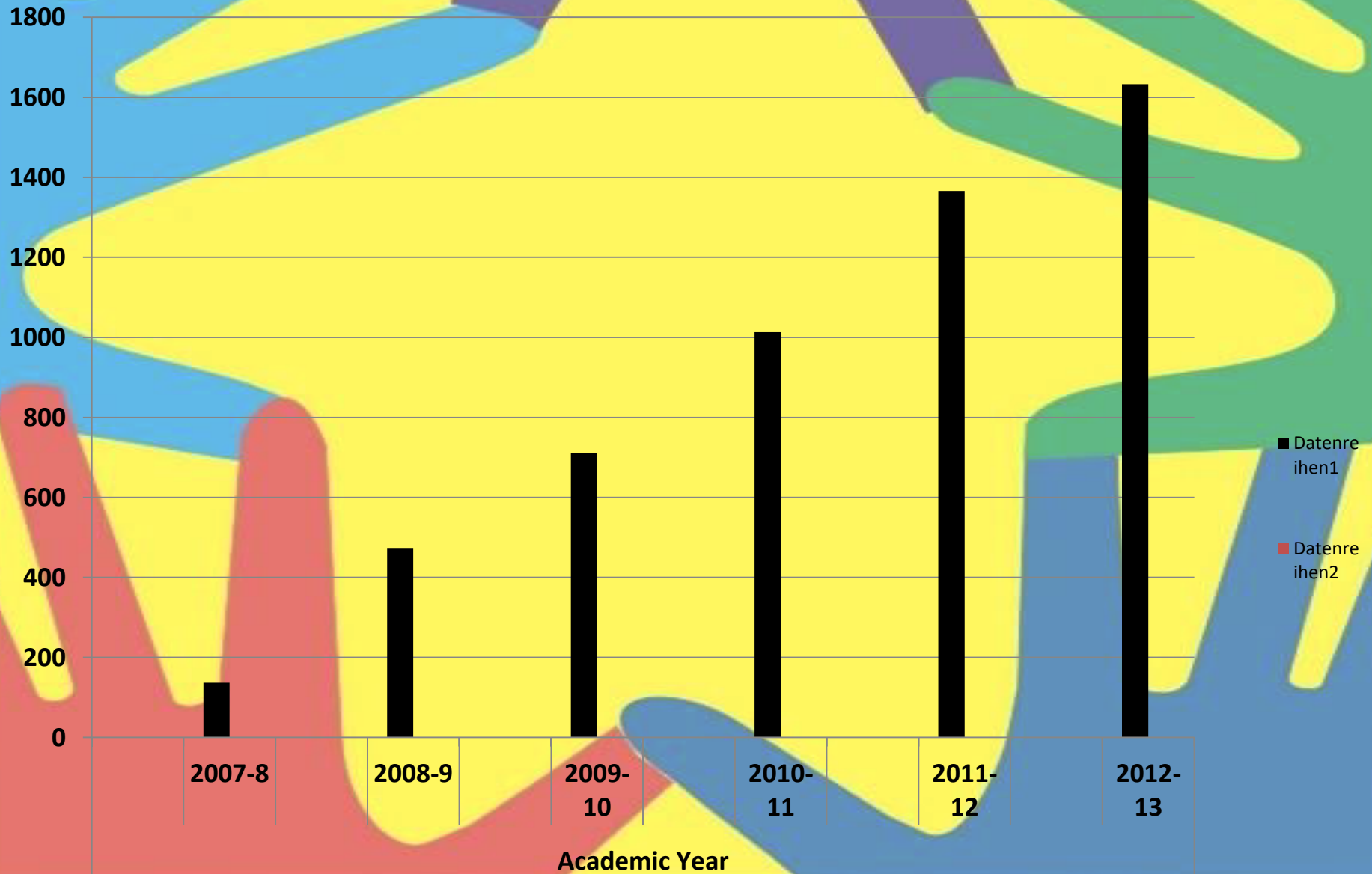
We are a proud family of 1968 students and 100 teaching and non teaching staff.
