When you visit an in-network provider, you'll receive care at our lower, pre-negotiated rates to help keep your out of pocket costs down — even if you haven't met your deductible.

You have the freedom to visit a health care professional or hospital outside of the LocalPlus network at any time, but you will pay more out of pocket for that visit, except for emergency services. (See page two for plan specific details.)

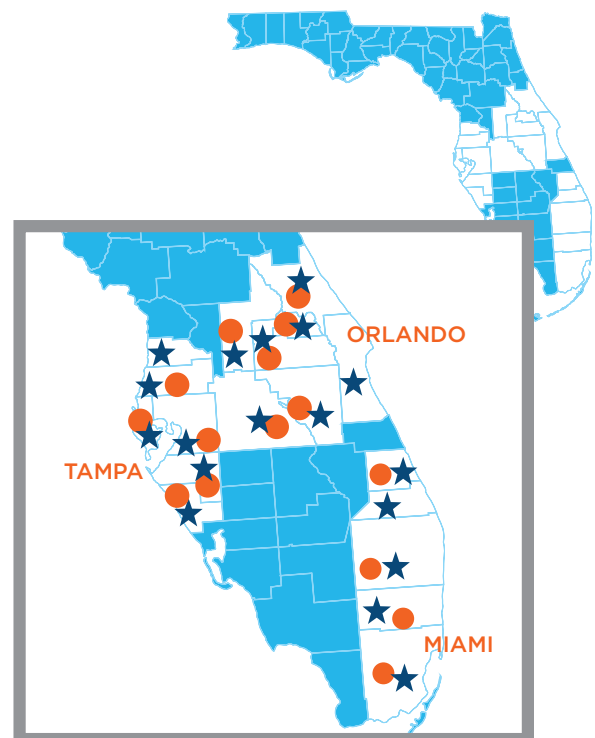
