**A**s the calendar turns, we are offered a new beginning, and a chance to be exceptional. Our Village is filled with a renewed sense of possibilities as we embark into 2019. I made it my mission not only to attract new businesses, but to also recruit diverse models of economic development. With that said, there are several projects we expect to see break ground this spring; **Pete's Fresh Market, Dairy Queen, and Alexi Development** to name a few.

In January of 2018, Sam's Club announced the closure of its retail store here in Matteson. Shortly thereafter, I immediately instructed our economic development team to contact Sam's Club in hopes of revisiting their decision. With contact from staff and myself, they returned to the table and in January 2019, a ribbon cutting was conducted for the repurposing of an existing Sam's Club to create the second E-Commerce Fulfillment center in the United States (the first center opened in Memphis TN).

A couple of months ago we had a major press release for our Master Redevelopment Plan for the 60-acre site (Lincoln Mall) Market Square Crossing. Market Square Crossing will be a diverse form of economic development that will bolster the viability of not only Matteson, but the Southland region. The excitement from that announcement has been huge, and we are now in talks with several developers regarding the Market Square Crossing site.

I would like to thank **US Congresswoman Robin Kelly, Illinois State Senator Michael Hastings, Illinois State Rep. Debbie Meyers-Martin, the Village Board, community leaders, Lord Companies LLC**, and the many residents who attended the press conference. These partnerships make my job easier. The power of our shared values is real and what we can achieve in the Village of Matteson is possible if we work together. Let's all work toward our exceptional potential as we move through 2019.

I'm looking forward to helping the Village of Matteson make progress on initiatives that will keep the Village moving in the right direction and becoming an even better place to call home.

## ComEd Spotlights Village for Success Utilizing Energy Efficiency Program

Representatives from ComEd and a film crew recently visited with the Village to spotlight our success utilizing their Energy Efficiency program to improve lighting and reduce costs.

A total of about \$250,000 in incentives were received from ComEd to improve lighting throughout the community. The Village is currently saving \$4,800 annually on the Matteson Community Center's gymnasium lights alone, and kilowatt hours usage village-wide has already been reduced by over one million kilowatt hours.



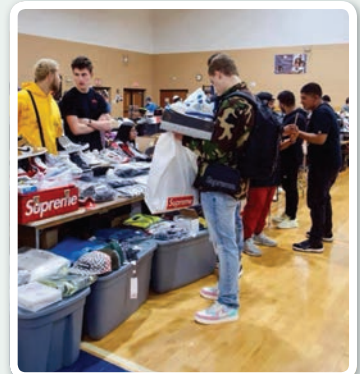
## Sneaker Con "Sneak Peek" Comes to Matteson

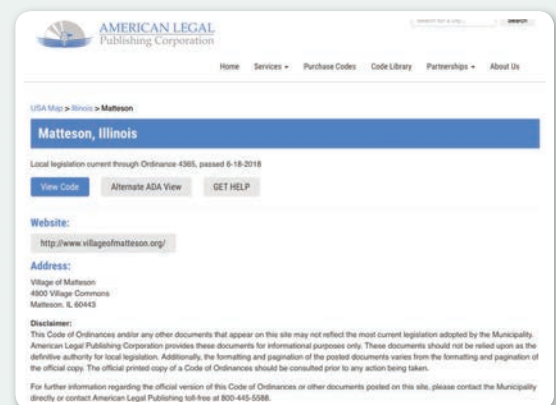


## Village Ordinances are Now Online

# Registration Information / Table of Contents

**The Matteson Recreational Services Department is a department of the village. It is, therefore, supported by your tax dollars.**

**The activities listed in this brochure are for your leisure time enjoyment. We hope that you are able to actively participate in the programs of your choice.**

**If there is any activity that you would like to be involved with but do not see offered, let us know. We are working for you.**

**RESIDENTS HAVE PRIORITY** - A Resident is anyone living in the geographic boundaries of the Village of Matteson and pay taxes to The Matteson Recreational Services Department.

**NON-RESIDENTS** - Will pay an additional fee as indicated by "NR" excluding those residing in a "cooperative" town.

**INFORMATION ACCURACY** - It is extremely important, for your protection and ours, that all information given to us is completely accurate. If any information is proven to be misleading or false, the participant will be dropped from the activity with no refund.

**RETURNED CHECKS** - There will be a \$35.00 service charge for any check that is returned to the Village from the participant's bank. Cash or money orders will only be accepted from those individuals.

**TELEPHONE REGISTRATION** - Telephone registration will NOT be accepted for any activity that requires a fee. However, if the activity is free, necessary registration may be done by telephone.

**FAX REGISTRATION** - Registration can be completed by fax if you are paying by credit card. Please use the registration form on page 5.

**INSURANCE** - The Matteson Recreational Services Department assumes no responsibility for personal injuries or loss of property while attending a Department Sponsored activity or facility.

**REFUND POLICY:**

1. Request for refunds MUST be made 7 days prior to the starting date of the activity. A \$5.00 fee will be assessed. Once a class begins no refund will be given.
2. If an individual is unable to complete their participation for medical reasons, the registration fee will be pro-rated (on a class-by-class basis), a \$5.00 fee will be subtracted and the balance will be refunded. An original copy of the physician's statement is required prior to the end of the activity to process the refund.
3. Please allow 3 weeks for refund checks to be mailed.
4. Once a team registers for a league, there will be NO refunds given.

**PROGRAM FEE** - You may register for a program after the start date providing there is space available, with the instructor's consent and at the full stated fee.

**AGE REQUIREMENTS** - Participants should be within the age range stated in the individual program listing. This is done for their safety and class continuity.

**REGISTRATION** - will be taken until the program's registration deadline or the participant maximum for the program is reached, whichever comes first.

**CANCELED PROGRAMS** - The Matteson Recreational Services Department reserves the right to cancel or postpone any activity one week or less prior to the start of that activity. If the activity is canceled, those enrolled will receive a full refund.

**WAITING LISTS** - If a program is filled, waiting lists will be formed. Every attempt will be made to accommodate persons on these lists.

**NOTES:**

1. You may register friends or neighbors for activities if you bring proof of their residency AND their signed registration form.

**FACILITY RENTAL** - The Matteson Recreational Services Department has room rentals (including pool party rentals) at the Community Center, 20642 Matteson Avenue, and room rentals at the Oakwood Recreation Center (4450 Oakwood Lane). Athletic fields are available for rental when they are not being used for our league play. Individuals, groups, organizations or businesses may apply at the business office for a permit. All permits must be completed and fees paid at least 7 days prior to the date requested. For questions on rentals, call 708-441-4500.

### Oakwood Recreation Center Closing Policy

This policy covers the closing of the Oakwood Recreation Center due to either extreme cold or lack of electricity. We have a different policy from the schools.

The Oakwood Recreation Center will be closed:

1. If the Center's heating system is not sufficient to offset the cold (temperatures at 60 degrees or lower inside the center). Classes may be moved to a different room if the cold is isolated to just one room.
2. If the electricity is not working and the class or activity is held during the evening.

If you are not sure whether the Oakwood Recreation Center is open, you may call us at 441-4500 or the Village Hall at 283-4900.

### Park Rules For Your Safety And Protection

1. In order to assure the safety of children in playground, picnic and athletic areas, our department **STRICTLY PROHIBITS GLASS** in the park system.
2. Dogs must be on a leash (6' or less) and owners must clean up after them.
3. **NO** driving or parking of any motorized vehicles, including motorcycles, is allowed in any grass area or athletic field in the park system. Drive only upon established roads and obey posted traffic signs.
4. All park areas close at **DUSK**.
5. **NO golfing is permitted in any of our parks.**
6. **NO** weapons of any type may be carried by anyone in the park's indoor or outdoor facilities except by the police. These include knives, sling shots, BB guns or guns in a case.
7. **NO** glass, radio controlled aircraft, littering or profane language.
8. All Village ordinances must be followed.
9. If the police are called and if, in the opinion of the Police Officer at the park, there are continued violations of ordinances or disturbances, the officer has the right to revoke any permit.
10. Full list of rules and regulations are available at the Recreation office.

### Broken Park Equipment

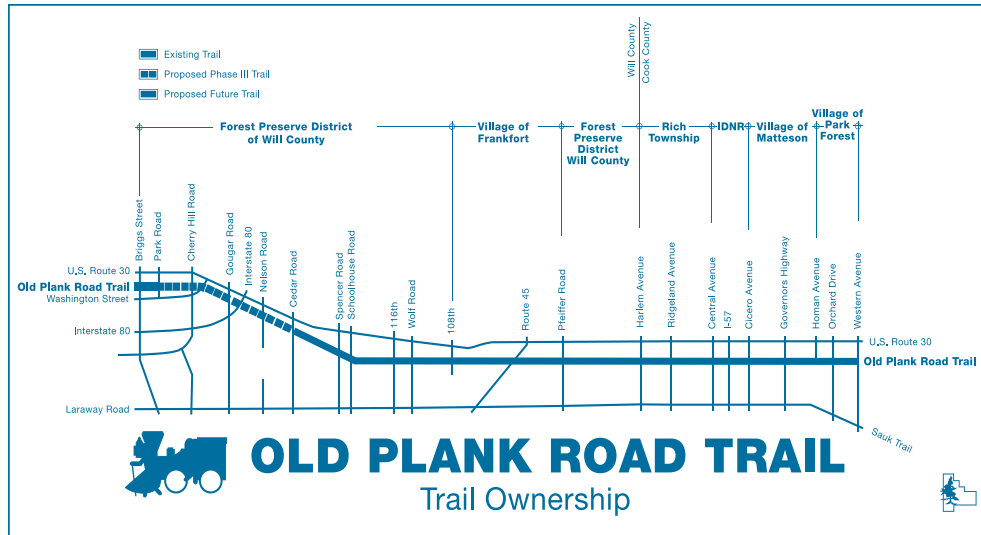

### We Love Our Parents But...

With your child's best interest in mind, parents are invited to their child's last class meeting. Our instructors have found that their quality of instruction had often been affected by parent and/or sibling distractions, interruptions and various other concerns during class time. We also feel it is most beneficial for children to have recreational time with their peers. Our instructors always welcome the opportunity to discuss a participant's progress with parents at any time. Thank you for your cooperation.

## The Old Plank Road Trail

The Old Plank Road Trail is a unique nature trail used by countless outdoor enthusiasts; walkers, hikers, bicyclists, in-line skaters, bird-watchers, and even cross country skiers in the winter. Developed and maintained by the Old Plank Road Trail Management Commission, the creation of this trail is a great example of intergovernmental cooperation providing outdoor recreational services to our communities. The Commission consists of one voting representative from each of the following governing jurisdictions; villages of Park Forest, Matteson, Frankfort, Rich Township and the Forest Preserve District of Will County. Several access areas are available through the Village of Matteson, as well as many other areas along the 20 plus miles of paved trail that exist from Western Avenue in Park Forest, all the way west to Park Road in Joliet Township. Brochures and maps of the Old Plank Road Trail are available at the Matteson Community Center or call 441-4500.

## Available Parking At Matteson Parks

The following parking guidelines should be followed by all participants in any of our programs or activities conducted at any of the Matteson parks. Violators not following the designed areas will be ticketed. (For off street parking, see Park Sites & Facilities.)

<b>Allemon</b>	<b>Absolutely NO parking on east or west side of Willow. Parking is available on Marya Yates School west or north parking lots and the parking lots at the east end or northwest area of the park.</b>
<b>Governors Trail</b>	<b>On streets where posted. Also limited parking (50) cars in St. Lawrence O'Toole's lot.</b>
<b>Memorial</b>	<b>Parking is available in the north parking lot and streets where posted.</b>
<b>Notre Dame</b>	<b>Parking is available in the east and west parking lots and on the streets where posted.</b>
<b>Oakwood</b>	<b>Parking is available in the west parking lot and streets where posted.</b>
<b>Woodgate</b>	<b>Parking is available in the north parking lot and streets where posted.</b>

## Picnic Pavilion Permit Information

- For an additional \$20.00 fee, electrical service is available at all picnic shelters.
- Permits receive 10 picnic tables only at the designated park site.
- Picnic permits do not include an Athletic Field or the Fieldhouse at Memorial Park. These are separate permits and require an additional fee/deposit
- Park Rental Deposit/Resident: \$100/Non-Resident \$150 due at the time of Permit Registration.

If a member uses more service time than they have purchased, they will be asked to return to the front reception desk to pay for the additional time.

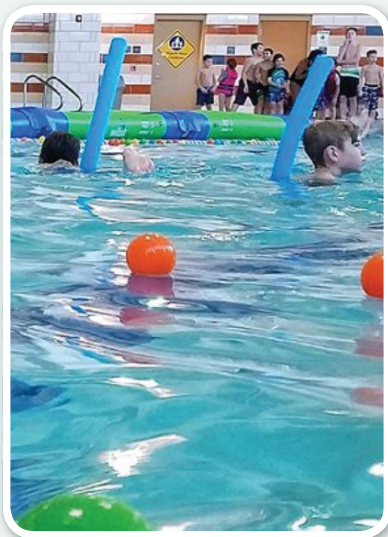

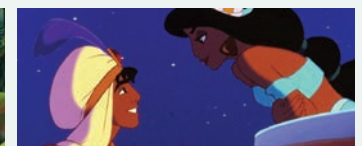

SSSRA is organized to provide individuals with special needs or disabilities the opportunity to be involved in year round recreation programs.

SSSRA programs are for individuals from birth through adult who are in special education classes, sheltered workshops or whom have recreational needs not met by traditional park district programs.

Persons residing in SSSRA member agency communities are considered residents. These agencies are: Country Club Hills Park District, Hazel Crest Park District, Homewood-Flossmoor Park District, Lan-Oak Park District, Matteson Recreational Division, Oak Forest Park District, Olympia Fields Park District, Park Forest Recreation & Parks Department, Richton Park Parks & Recreation Department, and Tinley Park-Park District.

Programs and special events are offered seasonally throughout the year. They include programs in the areas of Early Childhood Development, Cultural Arts, Illinois Special Olympics, Summer Day Camp, Sports & Fitness, Social Programs, Adaptive Sports, Special Events and Overnight Trips.

A complete program brochure is available at the Matteson Parks & Recreation Department and the SSSRA office. Please call the SSSRA office if you would like to receive the SSSRA brochure on a seasonal basis.

Professional staff with experience in the field of Therapeutic Recreation or a related field supervise all SSSRA programs. They are assisted by individuals who are trained by SSSRA staff in specific areas of therapeutic recreation.

Scholarships are available to SSSRA residents with disabilities who would like to participate in one or more programs, but cannot afford the fees charged.

Through the Inclusion process, SSSRA staff members are available to help participants choose an appropriate program, conduct staff trainings, or supply adaptive equipment if you or a family member is interested in a park district or recreation department program.

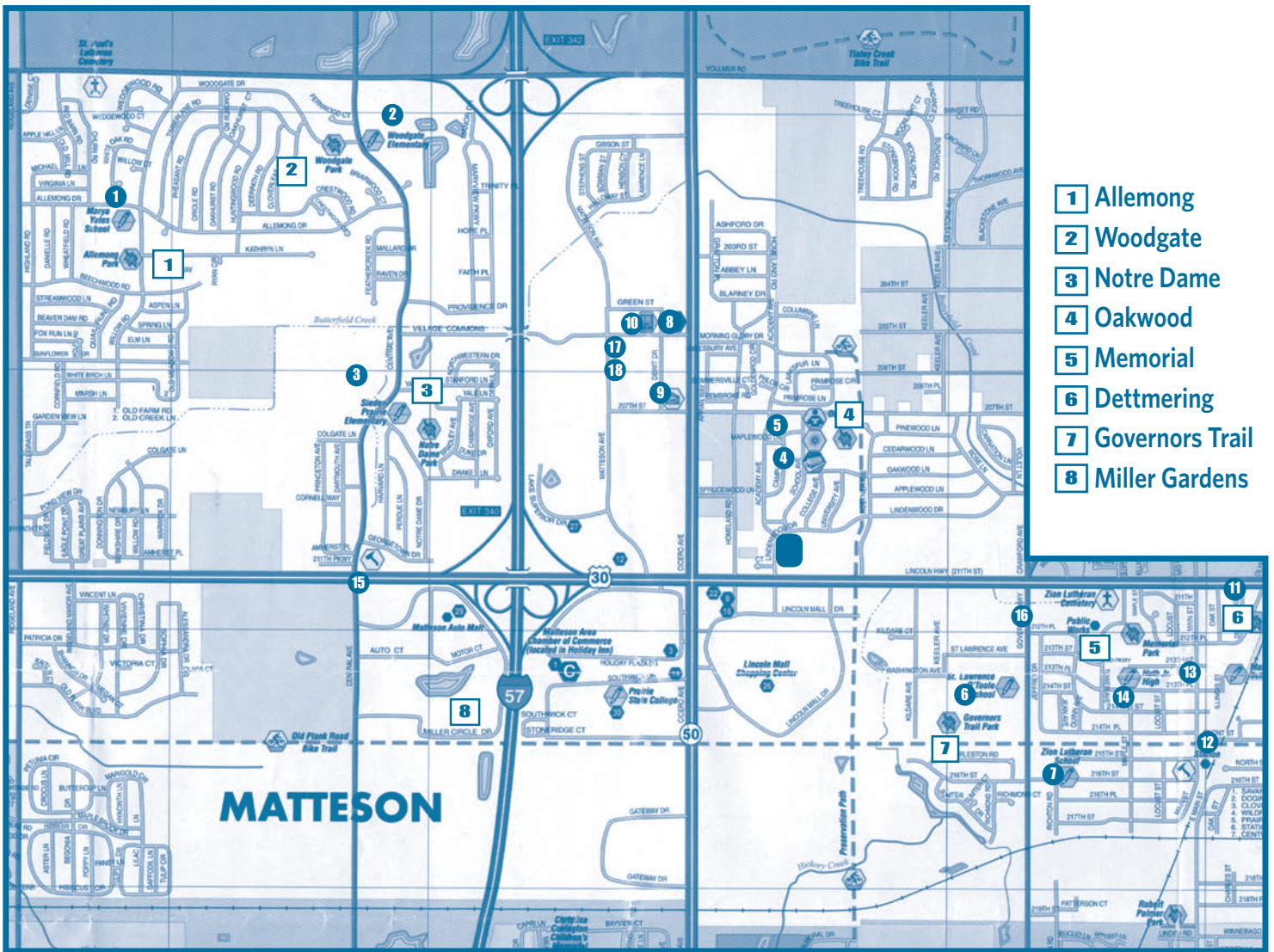

## New Plan Announced for Former Lincoln Mall Site

Village President Sheila Chalmers-Currin and the Board of Trustees were joined by The Lord Companies, U.S. Congresswoman Robin Kelly, Illinois State Senator Michael Hastings, Illinois State Representative Debbie Meyers-Martin, community leaders and Matteson residents in the announcement of a major new development for the now demolished Lincoln Mall site.

A master redevelopment plan for the 60-acre site, southeast of U.S. 30 and Cicero Avenue, was a top priority of President Chalmers-Currin upon being sworn into office in May of 2017. The redevelopment project entitled, Market Square Crossing, will offer significant commercial businesses, residential (townhome/condominiums), recreational facilities, entertainment, and pedestrian paths.

Earlier this year the Village of Matteson hired The Lord Companies of Chicago, to coordinate the entire plan. The Lord Companies will market the plan that is being divided into 14 lots.



“Market Square crossing will bring diverse forms of economic development that will bolster the viability of not only Matteson, but also the Southland region.” says president Chalmers-Currin.

The redevelopment plan outlines nearly 600 housing units (townhomes/condominiums) built into four-story buildings with commercial use at the ground levels. The redevelopment plan also calls for entertainment uses such as live theater performances, concerts, as well as indoor/outdoor sports tournaments.

“I am impressed by the focused planning and actions of President Chalmers-Currin and her administration,” said

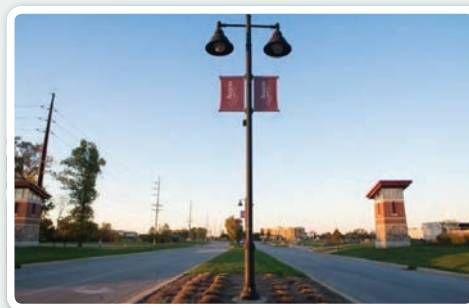
Representative Meyers-Martin. “Matteson is now the example of how municipalities should monitor and adapt to the ever-changing consumer shopping trends. Market Square Crossing will have a positive impact on the Southland region’s economy. This is an exciting time for us here in Southern Cook County.”

## Matteson and RATIO Architects Gearing up for Streetscape Improvement Plan

The Village President and Board of Trustees approved an agreement to partner with CMAP (Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning) to hire an architectural consultant, RATIO to produce a Streetscape Improvement Plan for Lincoln Highway & Cicero Avenue. The Village was awarded a matching grant of 80/20 for a plan last year.



The Streetscape Improvement plan will entail US Rt. 30 from Governors Highway to Harlem Avenue and Cicero



Avenue from Vollmer to CN rail. The plan will help improve safety for pedestrians and bicyclists by increasing connectivity between our neighborhoods and commercial areas. Additionally, the plan will include the use of wayfinding signage. It will build on recent planning projects, partnerships, and past success generated from the Master Plan for Economic Development and Land Use.

RATIO was selected from four consultants that responded to the

request for proposal. The RATIO team demonstrated an impressive understanding of Matteson and multiple disciplines, which will offer an approach that is ideally suited to the needs of the Village.

There will be a steering committee that will encompass staff, residents, and stakeholders in the community. Announcements will be made for public engagement workshops.

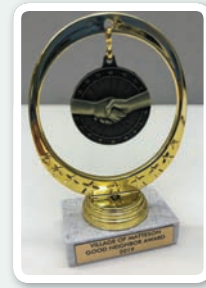
## Congratulations to the MYAA Cheerleading Program!
