ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admissions each year are based on the number of applications received, the academic qualifications of the applicants, and the number of spaces available. Enrolling an academically qualified, diverse student body is at the centre of the university's mission.

Interested? You'll need to present the following criteria:

- Completion of a three or four-year degree from a recognized college or university
- A minimum admission grade point average (AGPA) of 2.3 (on Concordia University of Edmonton's 4-point scale) or equivalent on the most recently attempted 30 credits
- Completion of 3 credits in English language/literature
- Completion of 9 credits from at least two of the following areas of study: archaeology, anthropology, classics,

computing science, economics, fine arts, history, languages other than English, mathematics, philosophy, physical education and sport studies, political science, psychology, religious studies, sciences, sociology

- · A volunteer/work experience record
- · Two confidential assessment forms
- · A philosophy of teaching statement
- Evidence of proficiency in computer knowledge and use
